10 or more races are chosen throughout the year (January to December) and given points based on their importance.

Those with the greatest number of points, will either be awarded with Race Champ of the Year or Race Champ Runner Up Trophies.
The total number of trophies that are awarded each year are based on the number of runners who take part in this Competition. See below.
Approximately $\mathbf{2 0 \%}$ of the total number of runners who take part in this competition will win a trophy as long as they reach the required Qualifying Points.

AWARD WINNERS, SO FAR, THIS YEAR = TOP 10 QUALIFYING POINTS SO FAR = 20 POINTS

Should a race fall on the same day as one of the allocated races the leaders reserve the right to award points, if they feel the race has more importance than the allocated race, but only if the runner competes as a Bourton Roadrunner or under their County of residence.

YOU MUST COMPETE AS A BOURTON ROADRUNNER IN A BOURTON ROADRUNNER VEST TO BE AWARDED POINTS

Races may be nominated as long as they are open to all ages (Can be various distance's,) but they must be within 50 miles of Bourton on the Water, to be considered as a Race Champ Race.
