
The following are some important details to help you have a great race day. Full up to date race info can be found on our website

Race HQ

The race HQ location is the **Cotswold Sports hall**, behind the Cotswold School, adjacent to the Leisure Centre, off Station Road, Bourton-on-the-Water (**GL54 2BD**)

Race Numbers (incorporating timing chip)

The race is electronically chip timed. All numbers are to be collected on the day, and will be available for collection from 08:15 to 09:30. Please arrive with plenty of time to collect your number (incorporating the timing chip). The Race HQ is a short walk from the start/finish area, which is in the centre of Bourton Village.

Parking

There are Pay & Display car parks (see map on page 1). Parking at the Leisure Centre is reserved for their customers.

Changing and Toilets


There are changing facilities at the race HQ and Portaloos will be provided. However, we are unable to provide secure baggage storage.

Race Start

Please allow sufficient time to get to the race start from the sports hall, which is short work (about a 5 minutes), using Moore Road (shown on the Start map below).

Course

For those new to the race, the start is in the centre of Bourton-on-the-Water, with two small laps of the village at the start (see below)



The route then follows an out-and-back course, along the Rissington Road, turning right into Leasow Lane towards Great Rissington, with a turn-point near New Bridge Lane. Upon return into Bourton village, there is a three-quarter loop of the village, having turned left after the post office, finishing close to the start (see map below).



Refreshments

Refreshments will be available to purchase before and after the race at the race HQ.

Important information

- If you suffer from a medical condition, please write this on the reverse side of your number.
- Please pin your number to the **FRONT** of your running vest.
- For safety reasons, ear pieces and headphones are not permitted and participants found abusing this rule will be disqualified, in accordance with England Athletics rules.
- There will be no refund of entry fees if the race is cancelled at short notice by the police or referee. Please check our website www.bourtonroadrunners.co.uk for up to date information on weather and course conditions.
- Prize giving will be at the race HQ, as soon as possible after the race.
- Online results will be posted by DBmax on their website.

You will be able to download his photos free of charge.
